
# REGIONAL OR SHARED 2025 UWMP



## 2025 Urban Water Management Plan

- Due July 1, 2026
- Required for all <u>urban water suppliers</u>
  - Provides water for municipal purposes to more than 3,000 customers or serving more than 3,000 acre-feet annually
- Historically, each purveyor and Calleguas prepared UWMPs individually
- Proposal:
  - Regional UWMP
  - Master Agreement to prepare individual UWMPs for participants

### Regional UWMP

- Shared/regional sections with supplier-specific chapters
- Calleguas would:
  - Prepare RFP
  - Contract with selected consultant
  - Manage consultant
  - Take the lead on the regional sections
- Purveyors would work with consultant 1:1 on supplier-specific chapters
- Examples:
  - Coachella 2020 Regional UWMP
  - San Bernardino Valley MWD 2015 Regional UWMP

#### 2.4.1 Regional UWMP

Water Code Section 10620

(d)(1) An urban water supplier may satisfy the requirements of this part by participation in area wide, regional, watershed, or basin wide urban water management planning where those plans will reduce preparation costs and contribute to the achievement of conservation, efficient water use, and improved local drought resilience.

## Shared UWMP Effort – Master Agreement

- Individual UWMPs prepared under a Master Agreement
- Calleguas would:
  - Prepare RFP
  - Contract with selected consultant
  - Manage consultant
- Purveyors would work with consultant 1:1 on their UWMPs
- Could have optional levels of UWMP consultant development support and pricing: peer review, update with retailer support, 100% consultant developed
- Economy of scale in regional compliance efforts and simplified procurement
